

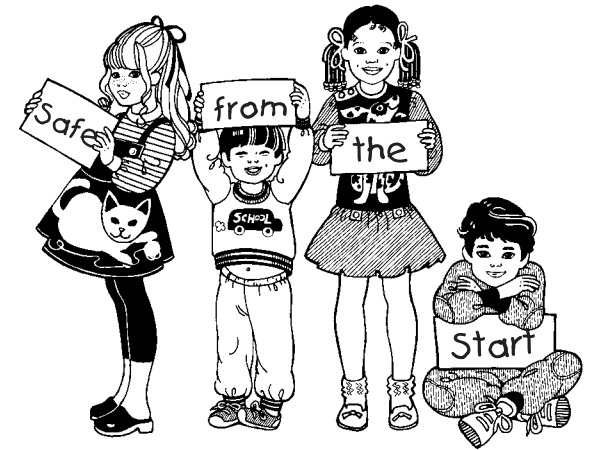

Hiring Help

If you prefer to hire a professional child-proofer, ask about the proofer's training and to what extent their work is insured. Be sure to check their references.
