



ARE YOUR TIRES SAFE? This one isn't.

This is one of four, nearly-bald tires that a Minnesota motorist had on her car when she lost control on a snow-covered highway and crashed into another vehicle. The person she hit was killed.

The woman was convicted of vehicular manslaughter.

It's illegal to drive a vehicle with unsafe tires. Check the condition of your tires regularly. It's one of the best things you can do to protect yourself, your loved ones and other motorists.

 This tire has almost no tread depth.

- Check for cuts, bulges and exposed ply or cord.
 These conditions can cause blowouts.
- Check tread depth. Tires
 with a tread depth of onesixteenth of an inch or less
 are unsafe and illegal. Place
 a penny head first into the
 tread grooves. If you see the
 top of Lincoln's head, you
 need new tires.
- Check tire pressure with a tire gauge. Tires can be as much as 50 percent underinflated before it is visibly noticeable.
